Phase o (now)

Architectural plans and development. Purchase of the property. Improve current structure, caretakers office, and camp director's place. Insurance for the camp and furnishings.

APPROXIMATE TOTAL COST \$2.2 Million





Phase 1

Construction of a fully integrated and ADA compliant structure (5 small cabins), 8 RV spots. Construction of playground, improvement of dock and add swim area, technology improvement, facility security, and new furnishings for cabins. Purchase of 1 boat, 3 - four seater UTVs, and 2 wave runners.

APPROXIMATE TOTAL COST \$1.3 Million





Phase 2

Construction of 4 double bed room small cabins, fencing for property, and purchase of an additional boat, 4-seat UTV, wave runner, and 2-6-person golf cart.

APPROXIMATE TOTAL COST \$1.5 Million







Phase 3

Construction of a fully ADA compliant swimming pool, 2 additional boats, 2 - 4-seat UTVs, 2 wave runners, 1 x 6-seater golf cart, ADA compliant hunting blinds and deer stands.
